# PROJECT DESCRIPTION

ecoATM's open space floorplan has an urban feel with exposed ducts and high ceilings. Packed with breakout collaborative rooms and conference rooms throughout, the design team mixed variable height walls to create a cityscape view from the second floor balcony. Since ecoATM has a substantial security concern, the team constructed an attractive way to integrate security equipment within sensitive areas that operate as selling points for prospective clients. Behind the building, the company had an emergency generator installed to provide backup power to ecoATM's mission critical data center. Due to the design and construction team's particular attention to material selection and construction documentation, ecoATM was awarded LEED Silver Certification.

# **ADDED VALUE**
